

Delaware Children's Museum breaks ground

Wilmington, Del. — The Delaware Children's Museum broke ground at its new Riverfront home Sept. 21.

The museum, which will be Delaware's first and only museum dedicated entirely to children, is set to open April 24.

The mission of the museum is to inspire children through play and math-, science- and technology-based learning. It's designed for kids aged 1 to 12.

More than 30 million children and their families attend a children's museum each year and the First State is one of the last to have it's own, according to a 2007 survey by the Association of Children's Museums. There are more than 400 children's museums around the world.
